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


SATWA means: So All The Way Around

Material:

- 1 Wooden support Étui à visser ® par Puca®- Paris
- 22 Piros® par Puca®- Paris
- 2 Cabochons par Puca®- Paris
 8 mm ø
- 22 Round Beads 3 mm (RB3)
- 5 g Delicas 11/0 (DB11)2 colors
- Seed Beads 15/0 (SB15)
- Glue
- Fireline 0.12








2) Close to circle and exit through the Piros HERE



3) Pick up 3 SB15 above the RB3 (always in the same hole of the Piros). *SATWA*



4) Here is the result Exit through the central SB15





6) Pick up 1 SB15 at each side of the Piros (in the second hole).



7) Here is the result Exit through the SB15 HERE



8) Pick up 1 DB11 between the SB15. *SATWA*



9) Here is the result Exit through the RB3 HERE



10) Pick up 2 SB15 between the RB3, pass over the Piros. *SATWA*



11) Here is the result Exit through the SB15 HERE



12) Pick up 4 SB15 between the two SB15. *SATWA*



13) Here is the result Exit through the third SB15 HERE



14) Pick up 1 DB11 through the two central SB15. SATWA



15) Here is the result Exit through the DB11 HERE



16) Pick up 1 DB11, 1 DB11 GOLD and 1 DB11 through the next DB11. SATWA



17) Here is the result Exit through the three DB11 HERE



18) Pick up 1 DB11 through the three next DB11. SATWA



19) Here is the result Exit through the DB11 HERE



20) Pick up 1 DB11 between each DB11 GOLD. SATWA



21) Here is the result Exit through the DB11 HERE



22) We glue the work on the support: bring down the work, put the glue and place the work again



23) Back to step 21.
Pick up 1 SB15 (under the DB11 GOLD) and 1 DB11.
SATWA.
Exit through the SB15
HERE



24) Make 1 round of SB15



25) Here is the result Exit through the SB15 HERE



26) Make 1 round of DB11.
Exit HERE



27) Make 1 round of SB15




28) Pick up 1 SB15 and 1 DB11 alternatively. *SATWA*



29) Here is the result ©
Exit through the SB15
HERE.
A flower has formed with the SB15 ©



30) Make 1 round of DB11



31) Exit through the DB11 HERE



32) Pick up 1 DB11 and 1 SB15 (under the SB15) SATWA



33) Exit through the central DB11



34) Repeat steps 24 to 33.
We get two flowers with SB15



35) Make 1 round of SB15



36) Make 1 round alternating 1 DB11 and 1 SB11



37) Here is the result Exit through the SB15 HERE



38) Pick up 3 SB15 between the SB15. *SATWA*



39) Here is the result Exit through the central SB15



40) Pick up 1 SB15, 1 DB11 and 1 SB15 between each central SB15. SATWA



41) Here is the result © Exit through the DB11



42) Pick up 1 SB15 between each DB11. *SATWA*



43) Here is the result Exit through the SB15



44) Glue the cabochon to the center




45) Then between each SB15 pick up 1 DB11. SATWA



46) Here is the result Exit through the DB11



47) Pick up 1 SB15 between each DB11. SATWA



48) Exit through the SB15
HERE (before the last
round of SB15).
Pick up 3 SB15 through
the next SB15 of the same
round to make the collar



49) Here is the result 69 End your thread



50) You have finished the first part



51) Make the second part. When pasting the second part (step 22) place the Delicas well to get a nice alignment



52) Congratulations! You have finished the needle case 😊



53) A real pleasure to realize 😊



54) I'm hurrying to see your realization 😊
