





1st Phase: Peyote Chain Link

Step 1

Peyote Chain Link


Measure 36" of thread, tie a knot around a single Miyuki bead (A) at the end, so that the beads will not fall off. Stack 4 Miyuki beads (A) aligned vertically, and thread stack with needle.



Step 3

Peyote Chain Link


Rethread 3rd Miyuki bead (A3).



Step 5

Peyote Chain Link


Rethread 1st Miyuki bead (A1). Pull thread to tighten cluster.



Step 7


Peyote Chain Link

Rethread the 6th Miyuki bead (A6)
Thread an additional 8th Miyuki bead (A8).



Repeat Steps 2-6


Peyote Chain Link



Step 2

Peyote Chain Link


While holding beads in place, flip threaded Miyuki bead stack over so that 1st Miyuki (A1) is on top of stack. Turn thread's direction 180 degrees, and thread a 5th Miyuki bead (A5)



Step 4

Peyote Chain Link


Thread additional 6th Miyuki bead (A6).



Step 6

Peyote Chain Link


Flip cluster of beads over so that 1st Miyuki (A1) is on the bottom. Turn thread's direction around 180 degrees, and thread an additional 7th Miyuki bead (A7).



Step 8

Peyote Chain Link

Rethread the 5th Miyuki bead (A5) Pull Thread to tighten cluster.



6 x Peyote Chain Links

6 Peyote Chain Links

Create 6 lengths of Peyote Chain Links, measuring 1.75" each, using elastic thread. The elastic thread will allow finished bracelet to expand for easy removal. Leave these 6 Peyote Chain Links unfinished for later use.



2nd Phase: Tango™ Tile Link

Step 1

Create Tango Square


Position 2 Tango™ beads to form a Tango™ Square. The holes of 1 Tango™ bead should be perpendicular to the holes of the 2nd Tango™ bead.



Step 2

Create Corners of Tango Tile Link

Create and position 4 Tango™ Squares to form the corners of the Tango™ Tile Link. Rotate each Tango™ Square (B) 90 degrees from the one created before it.





Step 3


Add Tile Beads


Add 4 Tile Beads **(C)** to larger square formation, using Tango™ Squares **(B)** as corners. Holes of all beads should align to form 2 concentric circuits of inner holes and outer holes.

Step 4

Thread Inner Holes Twice

Measure 36" of thread, tie a knot around a single Miyuki bead (A) at the end, so that the beads will not fall off the thread. Enter the inner hole of the lower Tile bead (C), and thread the inner holes of the Tango[™] Tile Link in a clockwise direction. Make a second pass through the same holes to reinforce the circuit. Pull the thread out between the beads that form the upper left Tango[™] Square (B).





2nd Phase: Tango™ Tile Link (continued)

Step 5

Turn Thread's Direction


Turn thread's direction 180 degrees, so that you are now threading in a counter-clockwise direction. Thread the outer hole of the same Tango bead just threaded.


Step 6

Thread Outer Holes Twice

Thread the outer hole of the lower Tango™bead that forms the Tango Square (B) on the upper left. In a counter-clockwise direction, thread the outer holes of the Tango Tile Link. Make a second pass through the same holes to reinforce the circuit. Continue threading through upper left Tango™ Square (B), tying a knot to close the circuit. Tie a knot, dot with glue, and tuck knot into the Tile bead on the left side.







3rd Phase: Join Peyote Chain Link With Tango™ Tile Link

Step 1


Join Peyote Link And Tango™ Tile Link


Wrap the 1.75" length of Peyote Chain Link around the Tango™ Tile Link.

Step 2

Join Peyote Link And Tango™ Tile Link

Thread both ends of the Peyote Chain Link together by rethreading the previously threaded end of the Peyote Link.





3rd Phase: Join 6 Peyote Chain Links With 6 Tango™ Tile Links (continued)

Step 3 Attach Chain Links Connect 6 Peyote Chain Links to 6 Tango™ Tile Links.
