Matériau :

- 6 Cabochons® 18 mm par Puca® - Paris
- 1 Cabochon® 25 mm par Puca® - Paris
- Seed Beads 15/0 (SB15)
2 color : Gold and Bronze
- 5 g Delicas 11/0 (DB11) Gold
- Bugles 3 mm
- Fireline 0.12
- 4 Jump rings 4 mm
- 1 Lobster Clasp



1) Set 6 18 mm cabochons like this :
Insert 44 DB11 and close in a circle



2) Make 5 rounds of DB11 with peyote



3) Place the cabochon and continue with 1 round of SB15 Bronze



4) Here is the result 😊
In the next round insert some SB15 Gold



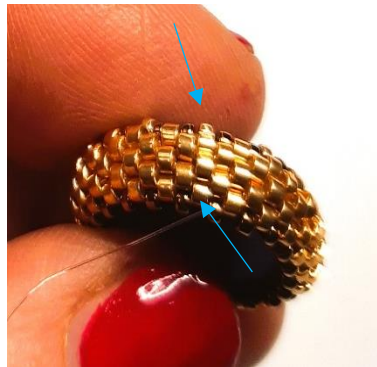
5) Insert 1 SB15 Gold and enter through the next 3 beads. Exit HERE. Continue like this for the entire round



6) Here is the result 😊
We create the star setting



7) Turn over your work and repeat steps 3 to 6 on the back



8) Advise :
Insert the first SB15 Gold under the SB15 Gold of the front part of the work like picture



9) Here is the result 😊



10) Insert 1 Bugle 3 mm between each space.
Here is the result 😊



11) Set the 25 mm cabochon with 64 DB11 and 6 peyote rounds. Repeat steps 5 to 6



12) Place :
Insert the 25 mm cabochon between 2 18 mm cabochons.
Follow the markers :
- Red = crossing
- Blue = spaces



13) To arrange follow the instructions :

- 1 red point for the junction between the cabochons
- 4 blue points for the spaces between the red junction points

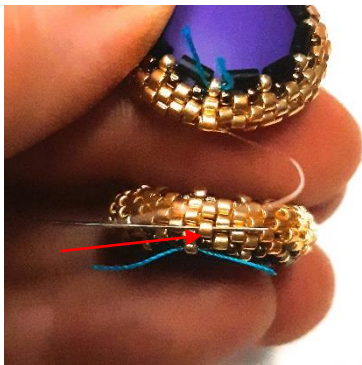


14) Assembly :
Insert a colored thread into the DB11 marked with red points like this



15) Place 1 DB11 HERE in the space between 2 DB11s.

Move diagonally across the DB11s to exit the same bead HERE (arrow black)



16) Place the 2 cabochons facing each other and exit HERE in the cabochon below (red arrow)



17) Reinforce.
Move through the DB11 to finally exit the same HERE bead but in the opposite direction (red arrow)



18) Enter through the DB11 inserted in step 15 (red point) and exit HERE (red arrow).
Reinforce !



19) Exit through the SB15 Bronze and DB11 like picture



20) Reinforce by passing several times through the 2 DB11s (red points)



21) Assemble all the cabochons following steps 15 to 20 like this



22) For the last cabochon, insert the DB11 into the red point. Insert 5 SB15 into the same DB11 and reinforce to form a bow (arrow black)



23) Position the rings and lobster clasp.

The « Adeline » Necklace is finished 😊

I wish you a happy beading. I offer you this pattern.
