Made by Puca®



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Material:

- 50 Samos® par Puca® Paris
- 25 Piros® par Puca®- Paris
- 25 Bicones 3 mm (B3)
- 25 Faceted Beads 4 mm (F4)
- Seed Beads 15/0 (SB15), 11/0 (SB11) and 8/0 (SB8)
- 1 Flat candle 40 mm ø
- Fireline 0.12



1) Alternate on the thread 25 Samos and 25 SB15. Close in a circle. Exit through the second hole of Samos



2) Pick up 1 Piros between each Samos



3) Here is the result © Exit through the second hole of Piros



4) Pick up 1 Samos between each Piros \bigcirc



5) Here is the result ©
Exit through the top hole of Piros HERE



6) Pick up between each Piros, 1 SB15, 1 B3 and 1 SB15.
All the way around



7) Insert the candle on the back. Exit through the top hole of the Samos. Pick up 1 SB8 between each Samos



8) Here is the result © Exit through the SB8 HERE.
Tighten the work well



9) Pick up 2 SB15, 1 SB11 and 2 SB15 between each SB8



10) Here is the result © Exit through the central SB11



11) Pick up 1 F4 between each central SB11



12) Here is the result © Exit through the F4 HERE



13) Pick up 1 SB15
through SB11 then 1 SB15
through F4.
All the way around
Tighten the work well.
End your thread



14) Congratulations!
The candle cover is
finished. Insert the candle
cover into another
support ©
