

Brooch Tutorial « Cathy » © par PUCA®



Made by Puca®

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Material:

- 15 Samos® par Puca®
- 1 Cabochon 25 mm par Puca®
- 1 Piece of Embroidery Cloth (PEC) 6 x 6 cm or Lacy's Stiff Stuff
- 1 Piece of leather or fine felt (6 x 6 cm)
- Seed beads 15/0 (SB15), 11/0 (SB11), 8/0 (SB8) Réf: 194
- 1 Brooch Support or Bail if pendant
- 1 Charm of your choice
- 2 Jump rings 4 mm
- Glue
- Fireline 0.12



1) Stick the cabochon on the piece of embroidery cloth



2) Place 15 Samos, 15 SB11 alternately and close. Exit HERE through the SB11



3) Place your work around the cabochon. We'll zip it on the PEC



4) Prick your needle crossing the PEC just flush with the cabochon, then cross again near the SB11



5) Exit through the SB11



6) Exit under the Samos through the PEC. Place the thread in the next SB11.

Do the entire row like this



7) Here is the result 😊 Come and exit HERE through the SBR11



8) Cut your PEC flush with the Samos



the SB11 above each Samos.

9) Pick up 6 SB15 between

Do the entire row like this



10) Here is the result 😊 Exit through the Samos



11) Pick up 1 SB15 between each Samos.

Do the entire row like this



12) Exit HERE through the second hole of Samos passing under the PEC



13) Pick up 1 SB8 between each Samos. Do the entire row like this



14) Pick up 6 SB15 between SB8.

Do the entire row like this



15) Here is the result 😊 Exit through the SB8





16) Cut your leather or felt the same size as your PEC ©



17) Prick the needle through the two layers (PEC and leather). Pick up 2 SB11 stitch in both fabrics. Be careful to respect the size of the two SB11 (about 3 mm)



18) Go up in the SB11, pick up 1 SB11 and stitch again in your two fabrics respecting the width of an SB11



19) The SB11s place themselves ©
Do the entire row like this



20) Here the result © End your thread!



21) Glue the brooch support or a jump ring if pendant. Place the charm with a jump ring

I wish you a happy beading. I offer you this pattern.
