Materials and Tools:

PRECIOSA Twin[™] (**Tw**) 117 01 323; 2.5 x 5 mm; 00030; 12x or 321 96 001; 2.5 x 5 mm; 00050; 12x

PRECIOSA Chilli™ (**Ch**) 111 01 357; 4 x 11 mm; 02010/26441; 12x

PRECIOSA Thorn™ (**Th**) 111 01 340; 5 x 16 mm; 00030; 6x

PRECIOSA Rocailles (**R**11) 331 19 001; 11/0; 17050; 6x

A 0.20 mm line – a length of about 80 cm; a sewing needle; scissors.


Procedure:

CHRISTMAS DECORATIONS MADE FROM PRECIOSA Traditional Czech Beads

Sew through each row several times, so that it is sufficiently strong. Before stringing the beads, check all the holes to ensure that they are clear.

Step 1:

String 6x **Tw** (fig. no. 1) and tie them in a circle with a double knot (fig. no. 2). Leave about 8 cm at the end and sew the end of the line in.



Step 2:

Pull the needle through the second hole of the Tw (fig. no. 3), add $1 \times Tw$ (fig. no. 4) and pass to the adjacent Tw (fig. no. 5 + 6). Repeat this around the circle (fig no. 7) and add a total of 6x **Tw**.







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Step 3:

The line extends from the second hole of the **Tw** (fig. no. 8), add 2x **Ch** (fig. no. 9) and pass to the adjacent **Tw** (fig no. 10 + 11). Repeat all around the circle (fig. no. 12), add a total of 12x **Ch**.











Step 4:

The line extends from one hole on the **Ch**, also thread the needle and the line through the second hole of the **Ch** (fig. no. 13). Add **Th** (fig no. 14 + 15 + 16) between the straight sides of the **Ch** and add **R**11 (fig no. 17 + 18) between the rounded sides of the **Ch**. Repeat this all the way around the circle until the circle is completed (fig. no. 19), add a total of 6x **R**11 and 6x **Th**.







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
