

FAYANS BRACELET

By Leslie A Pope





Named for Turkish decorative tiles, this bracelet has miles of style.

Skill level: Confident beginner and up **Techniques:** Stitching with two-hole

Finished length: 6 ¾" (excluding the

clasp)

beads

MATERIALS

- 1g size 15° seed beads
- 1g size 11° seed beads
- 26 GemDuos
- 40 Faceted microspacers
- 20 SuperDuos
- 2 size 4mm soldered jump rings
- 2 size 5mm jump rings
- Clasp of choice
- 6lb. Fireline™
- Size 12 beading needles
- Scissors/Pliers

TIP:

- Check that all holes of any two-hole beads are clear before stitching.
- Be careful not to skip any beads when retracing a thread path.

TILE COMPONENT

FIGURE 1

Step 1. On 18" of Fireline, string one SuperDuo and one 15° four times. Tie the working and tail threads with an overhand knot, leaving a small tail to weave in at your earliest convenience. Sew through all the beads once more and exit the first SuperDuo added. Reverse direction and sew through the top hole of the same SuperDuo.

FIGURE 2

Step 2. String one GemDuo, one 15°, one 11°, one Microspacer, one 11° and one 15°. Sew through the second hole of the GemDuo and the next SuperDuo.

Step 3. Repeat Step 2 three more times. Exit the first 15° and 11° added in Step 2.

FIGURE 3

Step 4. <u>SKIP</u> the Microspacer and sew through the next 11° and 15°. Pull the thread snug to pop up the Microspacer. String one 11°, one 15°, one Microspacer, and two 15°s. Sew through the SuperDuo going

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in the opposite thread direction. String two 15°s and sew through the Microspacer. String one 15°, one 11° and sew through the next 15° and 11°.

Step 5. Repeat Step 4 three more times. Exit the Microspacer, but <u>DO NOT</u> cut the working thread. Set this component aside.

Make four more components.

CONNECT THE COMPONENTS

- **Step 6.** Rethread the working thread of one component. Place a second component to mirror the first component.
- **Step 7.** String three 15°s, one GemDuo, three 15°s and sew through the Microspacer of the second component. String three 15°s and sew through the second hole of the GemDuo. String three 15°s and sew through the Microspacer of the first component.
- **Step 8.** Retrace the thread path at least once to reinforce the join (not illustrated). Secure the thread within one of the components and trim the excess.
- **Step 9.** Repeat Steps 6 through 8 to connect the other components.

ATTACH SOLDERED RINGS AND CLASP

FIGURE 5

- **Step 10.** Secure a new 12" length of Fireline into one end component and weave through to exit the end Microspacer.
- **Step 11.** String two 15°s, one GemDuo, three 15°s, one 11° and one soldered ring. Sew back through the 11°. String three 15°s and sew through the second hole of the GemDuo. String two 15°s and sew through the Microspacer.

FIGURE 6

- **Step 12.** String one 15° and retrace the thread path through the two 15°s, one GemDuo, three 15°s, one 11° and one soldered ring. Continue through the three 15°s, GemDuo and two 15°s. String one 15° and sew through the Microspacer. Secure thread within the component and trim excess.
- **Step 13.** Repeat Steps 10 and 12 to attach a soldered ring to the other end of the bracelet.
- **Step 14.** Use pliers to open a jump ring and attach one half of the clasp to one soldered ring. Repeat to attach the other half of the clasp to the other end of the bracelet.



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

Bracelet colors are listed as shown from top to bottom in the photo.

Matte backlit tequila – GemDuos
Opaque orange/red luster – SuperDuos
Pumpkin – 2x3mm faceted microspacers
Metallic light bronze – size 15° seed beads
Duracoat dyed S/L persimmon– size 11° seed beads

Backlit hazel sun – GemDuos Chalk green luster – SuperDuos Polychrome citrus sage – 2x3mm faceted microspacers Duracoat galvanized yellow gold – size 15° seed beads Turquoise Picasso – size 11° seed beads

Matte jet blue iris – GemDuos Jet blue iris – SuperDuos Capri blue – 2x3mm faceted microspacers Trans gray luster – size 15° seed beads Metallic plum – size 11° seed beads
