Made by Puca




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Material: For a 45cm necklace

- 134 Ilos® par Puca® (40 grs)
- 33 Minos® par Puca®
- 66 Paros® par Puca®
- 33 flatten bead like abacus 3x2 mm(PA3)
- Seed bead 15/0, 11/0, 8/0 (R15, R11, R8)
- 2 rings 0.4mm ø
- 1 clasp of your choice
- Fireline 0.12





7) Exit here




8) Pick up 1 R11 between all the Ilos of the rank



9) We have this 😂



10) Exit through the R11



11) Pick up 1 R15, 1 R11, 1R15, exit through the first R11



12) Repeat for the whole rank



13) Place a thread into the R11



14) Pick up 1 Paros (center hole), 1 Paros (head hole) between the R11



15) Pick up 1 PA3 between the R11. Go on and alternate steps 14 and 15. Be careful to place your PA3 under the llos!



16) Place 3 R15 in the last Paros like picture



17) We have this 😉



18) Pick up 1R15, 1Minos, 1R15 between the Paros



19) Pick up 1 R15 between the Paros. Go on and alternate steps 18 and 19



20) Pick up 3 R 15 in the last Paros



21) Exit through the R15



22) Pick up 5 R15 between the R15 and exit through the next R15



23) Pick up 3 R15, exit through the first R15, go on and alternate steps 22 and 23




24) We have this 😂



25) Place your clasp with rings into the R8
