

"Coeur en dentelle" design by Finuccia Sefi créationss

Heart FP Sélection® Necklace Tutorial


## Material:

- 1 Heart "Constellation" de FP Sélection®
- Seed beads Miyuki 11/0 (SB11)
- Metal Square 25 mm
- Chain and Clasp of your choice
- 1 thin Ring 7 mm
- 1 thin Ring 5 mm
- 1 Nail with bead 2.5 cm
- 1 metre of transparent 0.15 mm Nylon Thread or 0.12 mm white Fireline




1) Insert 4 SB11.

Close in a circle and reinforce.



Insert 1 SB11 between each seed bead.

All the way around.






3) We obtain a square.

Insert 3 SB11 between each protruding SB11.

All the way around.



Here is the result.



4) Exit HERE (arrow).

Insert 1 SB11 onto the seed beads marked with a red dot.

All the way around.



Here is the result.



5) Insert 8 x 3 SB11 between each protruding seed bead.

All the way around.



Here is the result.

Exit HERE (arrow) from the protruding seed bead.



6) Insert 3 SB11 between each protruding SB11.

All the way around.



7) Here is the result.

Insert 1 SB11 between each group of 3 SB11 from the previous round.

All the way around.




8) Here is the result.

Exit HERE (arrow).



Insert 1 SB11 using the **peyote** technique for the entire round (insert 1 SB11 onto the thread, skip the next seed bead and insert into the second one).

Continue in this manner for the entire round and **step up** (when you finish the round, insert into the last seed bead and the next seed bead, which is the first one inserted in this round).



9) Here is the result.

Alternately insert 3 SB11 into the larger space (blue arrow) and 1 SB11 into the smaller space (red arrow).


All the way around.



10) Here is the result.

We are HERE (arrow).

This SB11 is the first to be connected to the metal square.



## 11) <u>Connecting the work to the metal</u> square.

The square is positioned as follows.

The blue arrows indicate the position of the three protruding SB11s to be connected to the metal square on each side of the square.

Starting from the red dot, proceed in this manner for the sides of the square :

- 1) Pass the needle under the metal square and then over the square.
- 2) Pass the thread through the same bead and move to the exit point of the seed bead of the next arrow.


Pull the thread tight during this process.


12) Here is the result.

Connect the second SB11 (red dot) to the square as explained in the previous step and move to exit from the next protruding seed bead (red arrow).

While assembling the work on the square, locate the protruding seed bead (red arrows) that will be positioned at each corner of the metal square.

Please note: the connection at the corners is not done in the same way as on the sides of the metal square.





13) Exit HERE through the protruding SB11 (arrow).

Insert 3 SB11 through the same seed bead.



Exit HERE from the protruding seed bead (arrow).

Connect this cross to the square in this way:


- 1) Pass the needle over and then under the square.
- 2) Pass the thread through the same seed bead.

Proceed in this way to the left and then to the right of the seed bead to secure it well to the corner of the metal square.

Pull the thread tight.

Exit HERE (red arrow) to connect the next side.

As in the previous steps, continue in this way to connect all sides and corners to the metal square.





14) Here is the result.

Pull the thread tight.

Position the seed beads so that they lie flat inside the square.

Leave the thread inside the seed beads and the initial thread left hanging until now.



Cut the threads.

## 15) How to position the rings:

Using pliers, open the 7 mm ring and insert it into the top of the square inside the 4 SB11 HERE (arrow).

Insert the nail into the heart and use pliers to form a ring.

Insert a 5 mm ring into this ring and attach everything to the 7 mm ring.



The heart is positioned freely on the beadwork.

Insert the chain, rings and clasp of your choice.

The "Cœur de dentelle" necklace is now complete.
