

## Tutorial Beaded bead « Léa » par PUCA®



Made by Puca


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- 12 Kalos ${ }^{\circledR}$ par Puca ${ }^{\circledR}$
- 12 Piros ${ }^{\circledR}$ par Puca ${ }^{\circledR}$
- 1 wooden bases Jack par Puca ${ }^{\circledR}$
- 14 Strass Mesh (SM)
- Seed beads 15/0 (R15), 11/0 (R11)
- 1 eye pin 50 mm


1) Pick up 6 Kalos and close. Exit through 2nd hole of Kalos

2) You'll now have this. Exit through 1st R11

3) Pick up 1 R11 between each Kalos. Exit through R11

4) Pick up 1 R15, 1 SM, 1 R15 and exit through last R11 and Piros. Repeat for the length of the pattern

5) Between each R11, pick up 1 R11, 1 Piros, 1 R11, exit through R11

6) Pass through 2 nd hole of Piros. Pick up 1 R11, 1 R15, exit through 2nd hole of SM

7) Pick up 1 R15, 1 R11, pass through Piros. Repeat step 6 and 7 for the length of the pattern

8) You'll now have this. Close your work

9) Place the $2 n d$ element in your wooden base

10) Place one eye pin through the bead
11) You'll now have this. Exit through R15

12) Place Jack wooden base into your work

13) Zip the SM with R11. Exit through R11-R15-Piros-R11-R15. Repeat for the length of the pattern

14) Make a ring, glue 1

SM in the center ( 2 sides)

9) Pick up 1 R11, pass through R15, R11, Piros, R11, R15. Repeat for the length of the pattern

12) Bead a 2nd element (steps 1 to 8)

15) Close your work.


You can bead earrings with 2 Léa beads!
