Photo Tutorial



Material for one module :

- 1 Cabochon Vintage FP SELECTION®
- 12 Samos® par Puca® - Paris
- Seed beads Miyuki 8/0 (SB8)
- Seed beads Miyuki 15/0 (SB15)
- 2 Round Beads 4 mm (RB4)
- Fireline 0.15
- Flexible needle

For the Bracelet 17 cm :

- Make three "Maligorn" modules and multiply the quantity of materials by 3
- Chain with stopper bead

	<p>1) Place alternately 12 times :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 1 SB8,• 1 Samos. <p>Close in a circle with knots. Hide the excess thread in the work.</p>

	<p>2) Here is the result.</p> <p>Place the work face down.</p>
	<p>3) Fold 5 Samos towards the inside of the work and press them firmly onto your table.</p> <p>Pass 1 Samos and press the next 5 Samos firmly onto it. This is what you get.</p> <p>Here is the result.</p> <p>Exit HERE through the inner hole of the Samos (arrow).</p>
	<p>4) Pass your thread through the 5 Samos (yellow line).</p> <p>Exit HERE (arrow).</p> <p>Insert 1 SB15 through next Samos.</p> <p>Pass your thread through the first 5 Samos to return to the starting point.</p>

	<p>5) Place 1 SB15 like this.</p> <p>Consolidate by passing through the Samos again.</p> <p>Return to the starting point.</p>
	<p>6) Place on the needle :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 SB15, • 1 SB8, • 1 SB15 <p>through Samos HERE (arrow).</p> <p>Tighten well.</p> <p><i>Tip:</i> The photos of the following steps show the front of the work for clarity. It's easier to work on the back of the piece, depending on your preference.</p>
	<p>7) Place on the needle :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 SB15, • 3 SB8, • 1 SB15 <p>through Samos HERE (arrow).</p>



8) Repeat the previous step below and position yourself in the Samos HERE (arrow).



9) Place on the needle :

- 1 SB15,
- 1 SB8,
- 1 SB15

through Samos HERE (arrow).



10) Exit HERE (arrow).

Place 1 SB15 through SB8 above.

	<p>11) Place 1 SB15 through SB8 HERE (arrow).</p>
	<p>12) Exit HERE (arrow) and repeat steps 10 and 11 in front.</p>
	<p>13) Here is the result. Exit HERE (arrow) through the Samos.</p>

	<p>14) Place on the needle :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 SB15, 3 SB8, 1 SB15 • 1 Cabochon Vintage • 1 SB15, 3 SB8, 1 SB15.
	<p>15) Exit HERE (arrow) through the Samos opposite.</p> <p>Place the same beads (1 SB15, 3 SB8, 1 SB15) on the other side through the second hole of the Cabochon towards the other Samos.</p> <p><i>Please note :</i> <i>Once the Vintage Cabochon is installed, we'll move from one end of the two Samos beads.</i></p>
	<p>16) Here is the result.</p>

	<p>17) Exit HERE (arrow).</p> <p>Place 3 SB15 through the second hole of Samos HERE (blu arrow).</p> <p>Place another time 3 SB15 on the other side of the same Samos to go around it.</p> <p>Tighten well.</p>
	<p>18) Here is the result (yellow frame).</p> <p>Walk through seed beads and Cabochon to do the same thing on the other side HERE (arrow).</p>
	<p>19) Exit HERE (arrow).</p>

	<p>20) Place on the needle :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2 SB15, • 1 RB4, • 2 SB15 <p>through 3 SB8.</p>
	<p>21) Repeat step 20 in reverse to place the second round bead.</p>
	<p>22) Place on your thread :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2 SB15, • 1 RB4, • 2 SB15 <p>through 3 SB8.</p> <p>Tighten well to position the RB4 correctly.</p>

	<p>23) Place 2 SB15 through RB4.</p>
	<p>24) Place 2 SB15 through 3 SB8.</p>
	<p>25) Pass your thread through the twelve SB15 which surround Samos, taking care to guide the seed beads in the same direction.</p> <p>Here is the result (yellow frame).</p>

	<p>26) Work in reverse on the other side to place the SB15s around the RB4 (red dots).</p> <p>Then secure the 12 SB15s around the Samos.</p>
	<p>27) Move to the next position after the 6th SB15 (arrow) and add 1 SB15 to the SB15s that bypass the Samos.</p> <p>Move to the other side and place a 1 SB15 HERE (arrow).</p>
	<p>28) Reinforce all the work to get a fairly compact module and exit HERE (arrow) from SB8.</p> <p>Leave the thread hanging and make 2 more modules.</p>

	<p>29) <u>Assembly of two modules facing each other :</u></p> <p>Place on your thread :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2 SB15, • 1 Samos (bottom hole), • 2 SB15 <p>through SB8 of second module HERE (arrow).</p>
	<p>30) Place alternately :</p> <p>5 SB15, 4 SB15, 5 SB15, 4 SB15, 5 SB15 between each SB8.</p> <p>Continue on the 3rd module by repeating steps 28 to 29.</p>

	<p>31) Here is the result.</p> <p>Place at the end of the bracelet :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2 SB15, • 1 Samos (bottom hole), • 2 SB15 + 1 SB8 + 2 SB15 <p>through the top hole of the same Samos HERE (arrow).</p> <p>Continue on the other side to complete the bracelet.</p> <p>Place a jump ring in the SB8 and attach the chain with stopper bead.</p> <p>The "Maligorn" bracelet is ready.</p>
