

"SISSY" EARRINGS



Material (for one pair of earrings):

Matubo Nib – Bit (10 pcs)

Matubo Miniduo (10 pcs)

Matubo Superuno (8 pcs)

Matubo 8/0 (2 pcs)

11/0 Japanese seed beads (14 pcs)

15/0 Japanese seed beads (approx. 0.3g each colour)

- * 15/0 A pink
- * 15/0 B turquoise
- * 15/0 C olive

Jump ring (2 pcs)

Earring wire or any other earring component of your choice (2 pcs)

Beading needle and thread (Nymo, S-lon, Fireline)

Difficulty: Intermediate



1) String 1x Nib-Bit (narrow end), 1x 11/0, 1x Nib-Bit (narrow end), 1x 11/0... 5 pcs of each in total.



6) Exiting 11/0, pass your needle through 15/0 A, 15/0 B and Miniduo.



2) Slide all the beads to the end of the thread and tie a square knot to form a ring. Tie off and trim the tail thread.



7) Pass your needle through the top hole of the same Miniduo.



3) Exiting 11/0, pick up 1x 15/0 A, 1x 15/0 B, 1x Miniduo, 1x 15/0 B and 1x 15/0 A.



8) Pass your needle through the top hole of all five Miniduo beads. Pass your needle through all the beads a second time to form a ring. Pull the thread firmly.



4) Pass your needle through the next 11/0.



9) Exiting top hole of Miniduo, pick up 1x 15/0 B. Pass your needle through the same hole and make a small loop above that bead).



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5) Repeat steps 3 and 4 four more times to reach the end of the row.



10) Pass your needle through the top hole of next Miniduo.



11) Repeat steps 9 and 10 four more times to reach the end of the row.



16) Repeat step 15 four more times to reach the end of the row.



12) Exiting top hole of Miniduo, pass your needle through 15/0 B above that Miniduo.



17) Exiting 15/0 B, pick up 1x 15/0 B, 1x 15/0 C and 1x 15/0 A. Pass your needle through 15/0 B above the top hole of next Miniduo.



13) Pass your needle through all five 15/0 B. Pass your needle through all the beads a second time to form a ring.



18) Exiting 15/0 B, pick up 1x 15/0 A, 1x 15/0 C and 1x 15/0 B. Pass your needle through 15/0 B by the bottom hole of next Miniduo, through the bottom hole of Miniduo and through 15/0 B.



14) Exiting 15/0 B, pass your needle through the top hole of Miniduo, bottom hole of the same Miniduo and through 15/0 B.



19) Repeat steps 17 and 18 one more time.



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15) Exiting 15/0 B, pick up 1x 15/0 C. Pass your needle through the next 15/0 B, Miniduo and 15/0 B.



20) Repeat step 17 one more time.



21) Exiting 15/0 B, pick up 1x 15/0 A and pass your needle through 15/0 C.




26) Repeat steps 21 and 22 one more time.



22) Exiting 15/0 C, pick up 1x 15/0 B.
Pass your needle through 15/0 B by the bottom hole of next Miniduo, through the bottom hole of Miniduo and through 15/0 B.



27) Exiting 15/0 B, pass your needle through 15/0 A, 11/0 and Nib-Bit.



23) Exiting 15/0 B, pick up 1x 15/0 B and pass your needle through 15/0 C.



28) Pass your needle through the top hole of the same Nib-Bit.



24) Exiting 15/0 C, pick up 1x 15/0 A and pass your needle through 15/0 B above the top hole of next Miniduo.



29) Pick up 1x Superuno and pass your needle through the top hole of next Nib-Bit.



25) Repeat steps 21 to 24 one more time.



30) Repeat step 29 three more times.



31) Exiting the top hole of Nib-Bit, pick up 1x 11/0, 1x Matubo 8/0 and 1x 11/0. Pass your needle through the top hole of next Nib-Bit.



34) Following the same thread path, travel through all Nib-Bit, Superuno a Matubo 8/0 beads. Pull your thread firmly and tie an overhead knot between every two or three beads as you work. Trim the working thread.



32) Without adding any beads, pass your needle through all Nib-Bit and Superuno beads and the first 11/0 of this row.



35) The earring is finished. Use a jump ring to attach an earring wire or any other earring component of your choice.



33) Exiting 11/0, pick up 1x 15/0 C and pass your needle through the next 11/0. Pull the thread firmly so 15/0 C will end up below Matubo 8/0.

Repeat steps 1 to 35 to make the second earring.

If you decide to embelish the bottom part of the earring, use Superduo beads instead of Superuno in step 30. So the order of the beads in that row will be: Nib-Bit, Superuno, Nib-Bit, Superduo, Nib-Bit, Superduo, Nib-Bit, Superuno, Nib-Bit, Su Bit and 11/0, Matubo 8/0 and 11/0. Using the jump rings and the second hole of Superduo beads attach the embelishment of your choice.



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
