



Tutorial « Mon Ange » par PUCA®



Made by Puca



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Material :

- 12 Kalos® par Puca®
- 26 Samos® par Puca®
- 26 Piros® par Puca®
- 1 wooden base John par Puca®
- 26 Strass Mesh (SM)
- Seed beads 15/0 (R15) 2 Colors, 11/0 (R11) 2 Colors, 1 R8
- 1 caps 8 mm
- 1 Lucite Flower 20 or 17mm
- 1 Abacus bead 8mm
- 1 x 4mm cord end with ring
- 1 angel wings
- 1 round bead 12mm
- 1 x 10mm rhinestone spacer
- 1 x 6mm flat bead
- Small feathers
- Brass wire - Glue
- Fireline 0.12



1) Pick up alternately 13 Samos and 13 R11. Exit through R11.



2) Between each R11, pick 1 R15, 1 R11, 1 R15. Repeat for the length of the pattern



3) You'll now have this. Exit through R11, 1st and 2nd hole of Samos



4) Pick up 1 Kalos between each Samos. Repeat for the length of the pattern



5) You'll now have this. Pass through all Samos and Kalos to strengthen. Exit through 2nd hole of Kalos



6) Between each Kalos, pick up 1 Samos. Repeat for the length of the pattern. Pass through all Samos and Kalos to strengthen



7) You'll now have this. Place your work on John wooden base. Between each Samos, pick up 1 R11. Repeat for the length of the pattern



8) Be careful to place the Kalos in the middle of the wooden base!



9) Exit through R11



10) Repeat step 2 for the length of the pattern



11) You'll now have this. Exit through central R11



12) Pick up 1 R15, 1 SM, 1 R15, pass through R15. Repeat for the length of the pattern



13) You'll now have this. Exit through top hole of SM



14) Between each SM, pick up 1 Piro. Repeat for the length of the pattern



15) You'll now have this, exit through bottom hole of Piro



16) Between each Piro, pick up 1 R11 color 2. Repeat for the length of the pattern



17) You'll now have this. Exit through top hole of Piro



18) Between each Piro, pick up 1 R15 color 2. Repeat for the length of the pattern



19) Repeat steps 12 to 18 for the other side and exit through Samos like picture



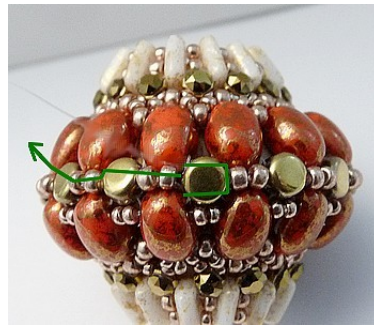
20) Between each Samos, pick up 2 R15 color 1. Repeat for the length of the pattern



21) Exit through bottom hole of Kalos



22) Between each bottom hole of Kalos, pick up 2 R11 color 1



23) You'll now have this. Exit through top hole of Kalos, and pass through all 2 R11 and top hole of Kalos for the length of the pattern



24) Exit through Samos, and repeat step 20 for the length of the pattern



25) You'll now have this. Close your work.



26) Glue your cap



27) Glue your feathers in your end cap



28) Fold your brass wire in 2 and pass it through the ring of the cord end



29) Place the cord end in the wooden base, it must be hidden into the wooden base



30) Pass the 2 brass wires through the cap



31) Place 1 lucite fleur, 1 abacus bead 8 mm, 1 angel wings, 1 R8, 1 bead 12mm, 1 rhinestone spacer and 1 flat bead 6mm



32) Make a pretty loop, turn your wire to strengthen



33) You'll now have this. Congratulations ! You are an Angel !
