Wire Miyuki 0,25 mm
Gold



Fireline wire 0.12

Material for a necklace 86 cm long (with medallion):



6 Heart
FP Selection



65 cm chain



















16 Rings 0.7x4mm


































6 Headpin 50x0,6 mm







1 Clasp 12 mm

			
1) Place the ring flat	2) Make a double knot with the golden thread	3) Place 2 DB	4) Pass under the ring
			
5) Move to the 2nd DB	6) Here's what you get	7) Place a DB, pass under the ring	8) Move to the 3rd DB
			
9) Here is what you get, repeat steps 7 and 8 and place 37 DB.	10) This is what you get	11) Make a double knot and cut the thread.	12) Pass the Fireline yarn through the ring, make a double knot leaving 15 cm at the end.
			
13) Pass into the DB	14) Place 1 R11, 1 F3, 1 R11	15) Pass into the F3	16) Place 1 R11

			
17) Place yourself between the 2nd and 3rd DB as shown here	18) Position yourself between the 3rd and 4th DB	19) Place 1 R11, 1 T3, 1 R11, repeat steps 15 to 18, placing 18 F3.	20) This is what you get
			
21) Pass into the next R11 and the F3.	22) Place yourself in the R11 as shown here	23) Place 1 R15, 2 Amos, 1 R15 in the next R11	24) Like this
			
25) Place 1 Kalos	26) Repeat steps 23 and 25 all around.	27) This is what you get	28) Place yourself in the 1st Amos
			
29) Pass into the second hole of Amos	30) Place 1 R15 in the second hole of the Kalos.	31) Place 1 R15 in the second hole of Amos.	32) Pass into the second hole of the next Amos. Repeat steps 30 to 32 (repeat all around)

			
33) You get this	34) Place 1 R15, 1 Pilos, 1 R15 in the second hole of the following Amos	35) Pass to the next Amos	36) Place 1 R15, 1 T3, 1 R15 in the following Amos
			
37) Move to the next Amos	38) Place 1 R15, 1 T3, 1 R15 again	39) Move to the next Amos	40) Place 1 R15, 1 Pilos, 1 R15
			
41) Move to the next Amos. Repeat steps 38 and 39, all the way around	42) This is what you get	43) Make a double knot, cut the thread	44) Thread the end of the wire and place yourself in the DB
			
45) Place yourself here	46) Place 1 R11, the heart, 1 R11	47) Pass again into the heart, the R11	48) Passe again into the DB

			
49) Make a double knot and cut the thread. Congratulations! Your medallion is ready.	50) Cut the chain: 2 x 2.5 cm, 4 x 3.5 cm, 2 x 22 cm	51) Place your headpin on the 6 cores and form a pretty loop.	52) Place the ring in the chain and 2.5 cm core, place another ring at the end of the chain in the medallion's pilus
53) Place a ring in the 3 cm chain and the first heart	54) Place a ring and the second heart, repeat steps 53 and 54.	55) Then place a ring in the 22 cm chain and a ring at the end	56) Repeat steps 52 to 55 on the other side, placing your clasp at the end.
