



« PAULINE » Necklace Tutorial



Made by Puca



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Materials for a 95 cm necklace (6 elements):




- 24 Arcos® par Puca®
- 24 Minos® par Puca®
- 6 SW Crystal Pearls 3mm (CP3)
- 24 SW Crystal Pearls 4mm (CP4)
- 100 SW Crystal Pearls 6mm (CP6)
- Seed Beads 15/0 (SB15)
- Seed Beads 11/0 (R11)
- Seed Beads 8/0 (R8)
- 1 clasp (optional)
- Jump rings 4 mm
- Fireline 0.12

<p>1) Add 1 Arcos, 3 SB15, 1 SB11, 3 SB15 and pass through the 3rd hole of Arcos.</p>	<p>2) Add 1 SB11 and repeat step 1.</p>	<p>3) Make 4 elements alternating steps 1 and 2. Pass through the 1st Arcos + 3 SB15 and exit out to the top SB11.</p>
<p>4) Pick up 1 SB15, 1 SB8, 1 SB15, pass again through the SB 11 to make a loop and then pass through the next 3 SB15.</p>	<p>5) Pick up 1 SB11, 1 CP4, 1 SB11, pass through the 3 SB15 from the next element and exit out to the top SB11.</p>	<p>6) Pick up 3 SB15 and pass again through the SB 11 to make a loop.</p>

<p>7) Repeat the following sequence of steps: 5+4+5+6+5, then pass again through all the beads to strengthen and exit through the SB11 (between 2 Arcos). As you see in the picture, SB8 are placed in opposite sides, up and down.</p>	<p>8) Add 1 SB15, 1 Minos, 1 SB15 and pass through the next SB11.</p>	<p>9) Repeat step 8 three more times and exit through the Minos.</p>

<p>10) Add 1 SB11 between each Minos and exit through SB11.</p>	<p>11) Add 1 CP3 and pass through the opposite SB11. Now you can tight a knot. You finished the 1st element. Repeat step 1 to 11 to make another 5 elements.</p>	<p>12) Now we will make the chain of the necklace. String 1 CP6, 1 SB15, CP6, 1 SB15, 1 CP6, 1 SB15, CP6, 1 SB15, 1 SB8, 1 SB15.</p>

<p>13) Pass again to the last CP6, then through all the beads and exit through the first CP added.</p>	<p>14) Repeating the sequences of the steps 12, add 11 CP6 and SB15. Then add 1 SB15, 1 SB8, 1 SB15.</p>	<p>15) Pass again through the last CP6, then through all the beads.</p>

		
<p>16) You can tight a knot (without tightening too much) and pass again through all the beads to strengthen. Make a total of 6 chains with 15 CP6 like in step 12 to step 16 and 1 chain only with 10 CP6.</p>	<p>17) To attach the 6 previous elements, add the jump rings between SB8 of each 2 elements. You must have now a total of 6 elements and 7 chains.</p>	<p>18) Now you can add the clasp. Congratulations! You have done the "Pauline" necklace.</p>
