

Bottle Cap Tutorial « Polka » © par PUCA®



Made by Puca®



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Material:

- 12 Lipsi® par Puca®- Paris
- 12 Piros® par Puca- Paris
- 6 Kalos[®] par Puca[®]- Paris
- 1 Cap Léa® par Puca®- Paris
- Seed Beads 15/0 (SB15), 11/0 (SB11)
- 6 Round beads 3 mm (RB3)
- 12 Mini drops of your choice
- Glue
- Fireline 0.12



1) Alternate 12 Lipsi and 12 SB11 on your thread



2) Close and exit HERE through the SB11



3) Pick up 1 SB15, 1 SB11 and 1 SB15 through the next SB11



4) Here is the result © Exit through the central SB11



5) Pick up 1 Kalos through the next SB11



6) Pick up 1 Piros through the next SB11



7) Repeat steps 5 and 6 all the way around. Exit HERE through the second hole of Piros



8) Pass through the next Kalos, then through the Piros.

Do the entire row like this



9) Here is the result © Exit HERE through the Piros



10) Pick up 1 RB3between the Piros.Do the entire row like this



11) Here is the result © Reinforce passing again in RB3 and exit HERE



12) Pick up 1 Piros between each Lipsi



13) Pick up 2 SB15, 1 SB11 and 2 SB15 between each Piros.

Do the entire row like this



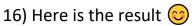
14) Here is the result © Exit HERE through the second hole of Piros



15) Pick up 3 SB15, 1 mini drop, 3 SB15 through the next Piros.

Do the entire row like this. Reinforce. End your thread







17) Glue the work onto the cap



18) Another color 😊
