

## Tutorial Bracelet « Prince'S » par PUCA®

## Material for a 17cm bracelet

- 22 Kalos® par Puca® (color 1)
- 44 Kalos<sup>®</sup> par Puca<sup>®</sup> (color 2)
- 42 round beads 3 mm (PR3)
- 44 bicones 4 mm (T4)
- Seed beads 15/0 (R15), 11/0
   2 Colors (R11)
- 1 Clasp single ring
- 2 rings 4 mm
- Fireline 0.12



1) Pick up 1 Kalos (Color1), 1 R15, 1 R11, 1 R15, pass through same hole of Kalos and repeat to strengthen



2) Pass through second hole of Kalos, like picture



3) Pick up 1 R15, 1 Kalos (Color2), 1 R15, 1 Kalos (C1), 1 R15, 1 Kalos (C2), 1 R15, exit through same hole of Kalos



4) Pass through all the beads like picture, exit through 2nd hole of Kalos




5) Repeat steps 3 and 4



6) Repeat until you have used all Kalos (22 color 1 + 44 color 2)



7) End your bracelet like step 1, pass through beads like picture and exit through 2nd hole of Kalos



8) Pick up 1 R15, 1 T4, 1 R15, exit through top hole of Kalos like picture



9) Pick up 1 R15, 1 T4, 1 R15, exit through bottom hole of Kalos like picture



10) Pass through R15 and T4



11) Pick up 2 R15, 1 R11 (C2), 2 R15 exit through T4



12) Pick up 2 R15, exit through R11 (C2)



13) Pick up 2 R15 exit through T4 like picture, you'll obtain a cross.



14) Pass through R15, Kalos C2, R15, follow the red line



15) Repeat steps 8 to 14 for the length of the pattern



16) Exit through R15, Kalos and R15



17) Pick up 1 PR3 between each group of R15-Kalos-R15



18) Repeat step 17 for the length of the pattern



19) Repeat step 17 for the other side. Close your work



20) Place a clasp with rings through the central R11



21) Congratulations, you have finished your Prince's bracelet
