

## Tutorial Pendant « Takamata » par PUCA®



Made by Puca



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## Material:

- 1 x 25mm Cabochon par Puca®
- 1 x 18mm Cabochon par Puca®
- 1 x 14mm Cabochon par Puca®
- 3 flexible flower caps 8 mm
- Seed beads 15/0 (R15), 11/0 (R11) et 8/0 (R8).
- 5 Grs Delicas 11/0 (DB11)
- 1 small teardrop
- 1 bail, 50cm of chain, rings and lobster clasp
- Fireline 0.12



1) Pick up 64 DB11, close.
Bead a total of 5
Peyote rows. Bead 2
R15 rows, place a
25mm Cabochon, pass
through to the other
side of the Peyote and
bead 2 R15 rows, exit
like picture, through
3rd DB



2) Pick up 1 R11, 1 R8, 1 R11 and exit like picture, through 3rd DB



3) Pick up 14 R11 between each DB



4) You'll now have this



5) Pick up 1 Cap, 1 R11



6) Exit through same hole of cap and then through the 2nd DB



7) Pick up 14 R11 like step 3, close your work



8) You'll now have this (3)



9) Pinch slightly your cap so it can fit the cabochon



10) For the 18mm Cabochon, pick up 46 DB11, bead 5 Peyote rows with DB11 + 2 R15 rows on the top and bottom. Repeat step 2 and pick up 9 R11 between each DB



11) Pass through 3 DB and repeat step 6. Pick up 9 R11 for the other side and close



12) Place 1 ring to link your cabochons through the R8



13) For the 14mm
Cabochon, pick up 36
DB11, bead 5 Peyote
rows with DB11 + 2 R15
rows on the top and
bottom. Exit like picture,
through 3rd DB



14) Pick up 1 R11, 1 R8, 1 R11, exit like picture, through 3rd DB



15) Pick up 7 R11 between each DB



16) Pass through the 3 following DB



17) Repeat step 11 and pick up 7 R11 for the other side and close your work



18) Repeat step 12 to link your cabochons



19) Place a small teardrop at the bottom of the 14mm Cabochon



20) You can place caps above or below your cabochons, according to your preferences



21) Congratulations, you have finished your« Takamata » pendant
