Photographic Tutorial



Material :

- 30 Amos® par Puca®, Mishmash Collection, Les Perles par Puca®- Paris
- 10 Piros® par Puca®, Bronze Collection, Les Perles par Puca®- Paris
- 1 Cabochon® par Puca® 18 mm, Les Perles par Puca®- Paris
- Rocailles Miyuki 11/0 (SB11)
- Rocailles Miyuki 15/0 (SB15)
- 10 Stormduos
- 10 Bird Feather Beads 5 x 17 mm or 10 FP SELECTION® Constellation Daggers
- Fine flexible beading needle
- FireLine 0.12 mm
- Leather cord or chain of your choice, lobster clasp and jump rings



1) String this sequence 10 times :

- 1 Amos lower hole,
- 1 Piros lower hole



Close it into a circle with knots.



2) The Piros beads will stand vertically throughout the project. Exit through the upper hole of a Piros.

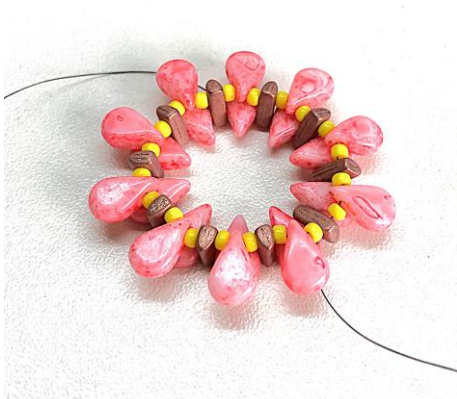
Pick up 1 SB11, 1 Amos (upper hole), 1 SB11. Pass through the upper hole of the next Piros.

Repeat all around the round.

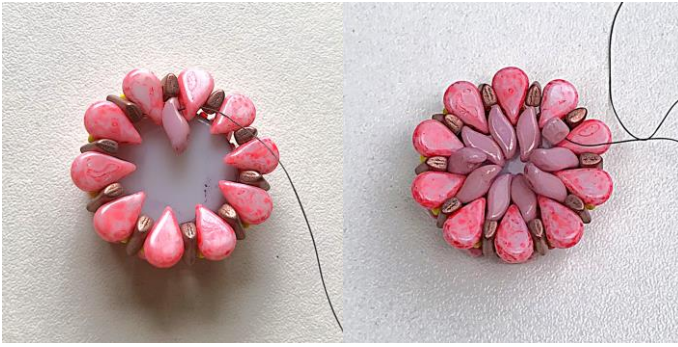
3) Move into the lower hole of an Amos.

Add 1 SB15 between each Amos.

Repeat for the entire row.



4) Place the Cabochon in the center. It will be secured firmly during the following steps.



5) Turn your work over and exit through the upper hole of an Amos.

Insert 1 Stormduo (upper hole) between each Amos.

Repeat all around.



6) Move into the second hole of a Stormduo and pass through all Stormduos.

Pull the thread tight.

Reinforce by stitching once more through the entire Stormduo round.

Then move into the lower hole of an Amos and into a Piros.



7) Insert 1 Bird Feather bead between each Piros, with the concave side facing the front of the work (if using Daggers, the orientation does not matter).

Repeat all around.



8) This step is more delicate. Work carefully without forcing the beads, using a fine flexible needle.

Tighten securely.



9) Insert 1 Amos (upper hole) between each Bird Feather bead (or Dagger).

Repeat all around.



10) Move into the lower hole of an Amos and add 4 SB15 between each Amos (lower hole) all around.

Above one group of 4 SB15, add an additional group of 3 SB15. This loop will later hold the jump ring and chain (or cord of your choice).



11) Here is the result.



12) Exit HERE (black arrow) through the SB11 located to the left of the Piros.

Add 7 SB15 and pass through the Amos below (if using Daggers, add only 5 SB15 for this step).

Add another 7 SB15 and pass through the SB11 HERE (green arrow), from right to left.

The blue arrow indicates the thread path for the next step.

13) Here is the result.

Exit through the SB11 located to the left of the Piros (arrow) and repeat Step 12 all around.



14) Here is the result.

Attach a jump ring and your chosen chain or cord.

Your pendant "Tragopogon" is finished.
