## Material:


- 12 Arcos®par Puca®
- 16 Konos®par Puca®
- 4 Kalos®par Puca®
- 1 Metal square 40 mm
- 8 Flower Metal 4 mm Ø (Daisy)
- Seed Beads 15/0 (SB15), 11/0 (SB11), 8/0 (SB8)
- 2 Jump rings 4 mm ø
- Fireline 0.12




1) Tie a knot on the bare metal square




2) Pick up 1 Arcos, 3 SB15, 1 SB11, 3 SB15 through the second hole of the Arcos. Pass the thread under the bare metal square



3) Pass the thread over the bare metal square and go through the Arcos




4) Pick up 1 SB11, 1 Arcos Exit under the bare metal square




5) Pass under the bare metal square and exit through the Arcos



6) Repeat the steps 2 to 5 to insert 3 Arcos.
Place well in the center



7) Pick up 1 SB8 and 1 Arcos.
Pass under the bare metal square






9) Pick up 1 SB15, 1 Konos, 1 Daisy, 1 Konos and 1 SB15 in the central SB11 that follows




10) Repeat step 9 and exit HERE through the SB11 passing through the lower hole of the Kalos



11) Repeat steps 9 and10. Do the whole row like this



12) Pick up 1 SB15 between the SB15 of the group of beads (SB15, Konos, Daisy, Konos and SB15). Exit the top hole of the



13) Pick up 3 SB15, 1 SB11, 3 SB15 through the SB15 of the previous step



14) Pick up 3 SB15, 1 SB11, 3 SB15 through the top hole of the Kalos. Do the whole row like this

15) Here is the result End your thread



16) Beads version: your choice



17) Feathers version: Insert a nail with beads of Glue the feathers into the cord end with loop 4 mm and insert a ring on the bare metal square



18) Tassel version: Insert the tassel into the cord end with loop and a jump ring

For the Christmas tree or pendant or earrings.
