



# Tutorial Bag Charms « Victoria© » par PUCA®

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Made by Puca



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**Material : For 1 Victoria bead**

- 1 « Jesse » par Puca® wooden base
- 18 bicones 3 mm (T3)
- 44 bicones 4 mm (T4)
- Seed beads 15/0 (R15), 11/0 (R11)

**For a bag charm**

- 1 clasp
- 2 x 4 mm rings
- 2 charms of your choice
- Round beads 6mm - 8 mm
- Eye pins 70 mm
- Fireline 0.12

**Other free patterns**

- « Léa© » bead par Puca®
- « Donuts© » bead par Puca®



1) Place 1 stop bead. It will be your reference point for the top of your work



2) Pick up 1 R11 and 3 R15, for a total of 9 times



3) Exit through 3rd R11



4) Pick up 3 R15, 1 R11, 3 R15, pass through 2nd R11



5) Pick up 3 R15, 1 R11, 3 R15, pass through 2nd R11



6) Pick up 3 R15, 1 R11, 3 R15, pass through final R11



7) Pick up 2 R15\*, 1 R11, 3 R15, pass through R11. (\*Be careful always 2 R15 first, at the top of your work)



8) Pick up 3 R15, 1 R11, 3 R15, pass through 2nd R11



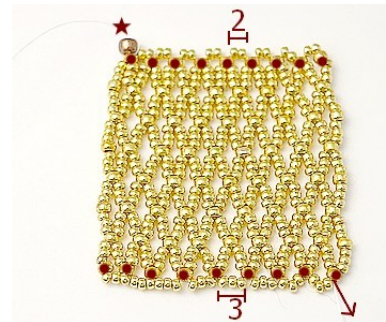
9) Pick up 3 R15, 1 R11, 3 R15, pass through 2nd R11



10) Pick up 3 R15, 1 R11, 3 R15, pass through 2nd R11



11) Pick up 3 R15, 1 R11, 3 R15, pass through next R11



12) Repeat until you have a total of 9 R11 at the top (with stop bead) and 9 R11 at the bottom. Exit through R11 at the bottom of your work



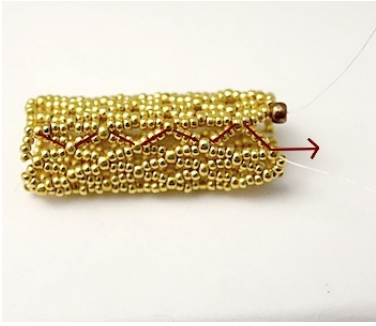
13) Zip your work. Pick up 3 R15, pass through R11 on the other side



14) Pick up 3 R15, exit through opposite R11, in zigzag



15) Repeat for the length of the pattern



16) You'll now have this



17) Pick up 2 R15, pass through R11, near stop bead. Remove stop bead



18) You'll now have this. Number 2 = top of your work, number 3 = bottom of your work (quantity of R15)



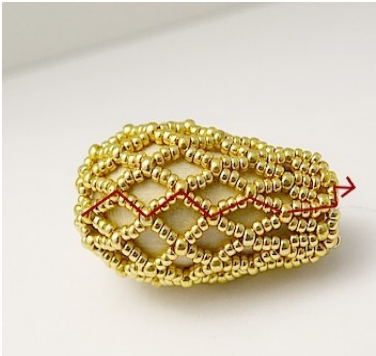
19) Place your work in your Jess wooden base. Top of your work should fit in thin part of wood



20) Pass through all seed beads and exit through central R15, bottom of your work



21) Pick up 1 R11 between each central R15, repeat to strengthen



22) Pass through all seed beads and exit through 2R15, top of your work



23) Pass through all R15 to tighten



24) Exit through R11 like picture



25) Pick up 1 R15, 1 T3, 1 R15, pass through following R11



26) Pick up 1 R15, 1 T4, 1 R15, pass through following R11



27) Pick up 1 R15, 1 T4, 1 R15, pass through following R11 and exit between R15 like picture



28) Pick up 1 R15, 1 T3, 1 R15, pass through following R11



29) Repeat with 1R15-1T4-1R15 twice and 1R15-1T3-1R15



30) Repeat steps 25 to 29 for the length of the pattern. Tie off your thread



31) Place a 70mm eye pin in the wooden bead and place round beads and charms of your choice



32) You can put together several beaded beads ! In the picture are Victoria©, Donuts© and Léa© par Puca® !
