



“Lisette” earrings

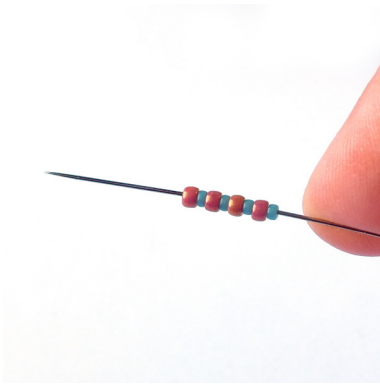
Simple and fun project with Matubo Miniduo beads



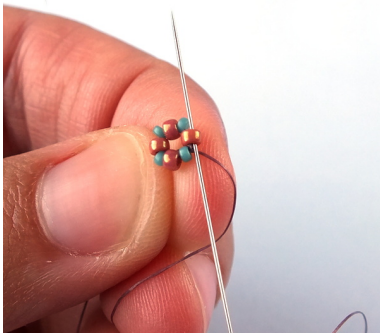
Material (for one pair of earrings)

- Matubo Miniduo (16 pcs)
- Matubo 8/0 (16 pcs)
- Matubo 11/0 (or TOHO 11/0) (approx. 0,5 gram)
- 15/0 Japanese seed beads (approx. 1 gram)
- 4mm round beads (8 pcs)
- Earring components, jump rings
- Tassels (or another kind of embellishment)
- Beading needle and thread (Nymo, Fireline...)

Difficulty: For beginners



1) String one 15/0, one 11/0, one 15/0, one 11/0 – total four of each.



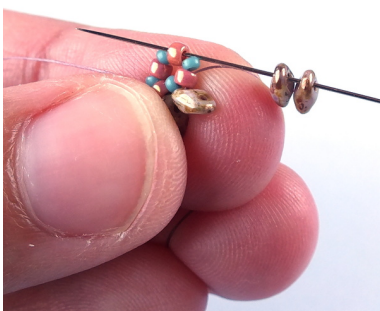
2) Slide all the beads to the end of the row. Tie a square knot to form a circle, then pass through the nearest 11/0.



3) Add two Miniduos and pass through the next 11/0 in the row.



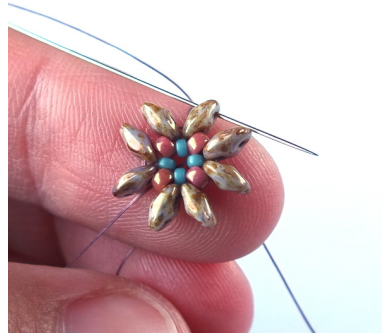
4) Pull snug. This is what you should get.



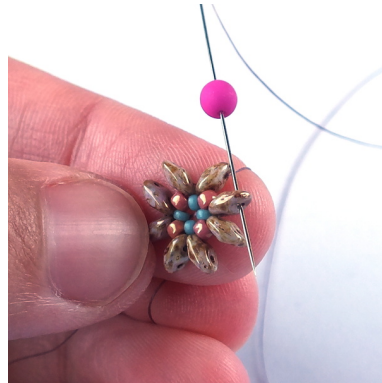
5) Repeat steps 3 and 4...



6)... until you reach the end of the row. At the end of the row add the last pair of Miniduos, then pass through the last 11/0 and through the lower hole of the next Miniduo...



7)... and then pass back through the upper hole of the same Miniduo.



8) In the gap above the 11/0 add one 4mm round and pass through the upper hole of the next Miniduo.



9) In the gap between two Miniduos add one 8/0 and then pass through the upper hole of the next Miniduo.



10) Repeat steps 8 and 9...

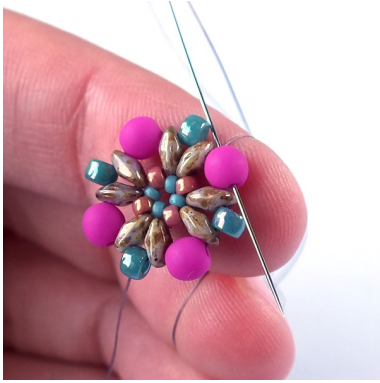


11)... until you reach the end of the row.

At the end of the row add one last 8/0, pass through the upper hole of the last Miniduo...



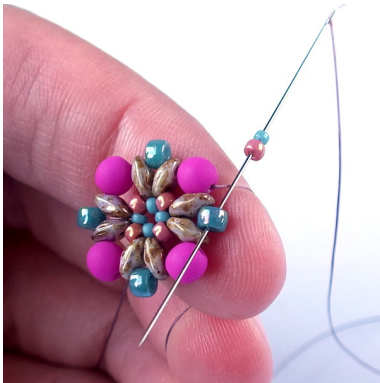
16) Pass through the next pair of (15/0, 11/0).



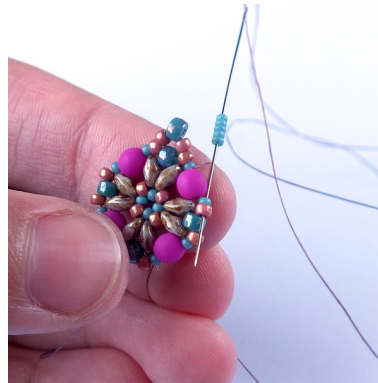
12)... and then through the first 4mm round in the row.



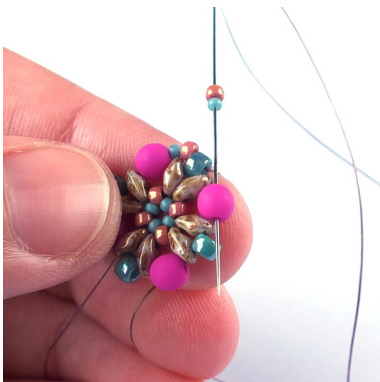
17) Add one 11/0, one 8/0 and one 11/0 and then pass through the next pair of (11/0, 15/0).



13) Add one 15/0 and one 11/0 and pass through the next 8/0.



18) Add five 15/0s and pass through the next pair of (15/0, 11/0).



14) Add one 11/0 and one 15/0 and pass through the next 4mm round.



19) Repeat steps 17 and 18...



15) Repeat steps 13 and 14, until you reach the end of the row.



20)... until you reach the end of the row.

21) Pass through the next 11/0...



25) Repeat steps 21 - 24...



22)... skip the 8/0 and pass through the next 11/0...



26)... until you reach the end of the row.



23)... and then through the next pair of (11/0, 15/0).



27) Tie a few half-hitch knots and cut off all the remaining thread.



24) Add five 15/0s and pass through the next pair of (15/0, 11/0).



28) Use jump rings to attach earring components and tassels to the earring.
